Our seven-day trip gives you the chance to capture the northern lights (aurora borealis), migratory wildlife and birds, including barrenground caribou, grizzly bears, tundra swans and peregrine falcons. View special points of interest while in the City of Yellowknife before flying to Peterson's Point Lake Lodge. It's not just flying 200 miles over the taiga shield to the tundra that gives you the sense of adventure, it is discovering the intricate beauty of the tundra and learning about the history of early explorers as well as aboriginal people who travelled through this area.

Your photo guide is Dr. Robert Berdan. Robert is a professional nature photographer with numerous photos published in books and magazines (e.g. Outdoor Photography Canada, Photo Life, Canadian Geographic). Robert has been involved with photography for over 35 years and teaching workshops for the past 20 years.
