



# Arctic Photography Adventure

This seven-day program gives you the opportunity to capture the northern lights (aurora borealis), migratory wildlife and birds, including barrenground caribou, grizzly bears, tundra swans and peregrine falcons as well and discover the intricate beauty of the tundra. Learn about the exciting history of early explorers, including Sir John Franklin and Samuel Hearne as well as the aboriginal peoples who traveled though this area. Includes two nights in Yellowknife and four nights at Peterson's Point Lake Lodge. Accessible only by float plane, Peterson's Point Lake Lodge is approximately 215 miles north of Yellowknife, capital of the Northwest Territories.
